2018 Community Health Needs Assessment report and Phase II discussion- John provided a presentation outlining the completion of a Community Health Needs Assessment for IUH Ball, IUH Blackford, and IU Health Jay Hospitals in 2018. - Mental Health First Aid

- Purdue Extension Dining with Diabetes
- Expanded walk to school programs
- Incorporation of smoking cessation with diabetes education

Tobacco Free Delaware County Coalition report-Jordan Moss noted that the current 2 year grant cycle would be ending in June 2019, and that he and the coalition members would be working on applying for another 2 year grant. He is still analyzing ways that we may be able to extend a grant to provide services in Blackford and Jay Counties in some form, whether full or part time and has 2 possible fiscal agents in mind. He is also formulating an initiative to provide coding guides for tobacco use to hospitals. January 30 is advocacy day at the statehouse, we are encouraged to participate if possible and Jordan will help arrange transportation if necessary as well as encouraging local students to go.
