



Community Food Box!

Community Lunch Boxes are a new initiative resulting from the Delaware County CDC Change Tool to address food access for limited resource audiences. These boxes would provide perishable as well as non-perishable food items. In addition we will have small cooking and eating utensils for those that need them. We are looking for organizations that are willing to host these boxes around Delaware County.

Boxes will be similar in size to that of the free-little libraries currently hosted by organizations throughout Delaware County. Boxes will need to be maintained inside the facility based on Health Department Regulations. Organizations that chose to sponsor the boxes will be in charge of maintaining the following:

1. Maintaining condition of box.
2. Restocking food and utensil items as needed.
3. Monitoring box on regular basis to prevent vandalism and contamination.
4. Washing of non-disposable utensils.
